## RIVERSIDE SPEEDWAY 2022 WINTER BLAST 100 RULES



DUE TO MANY SAFETY CONCERNS OF THIS RACE IN THE PAST, IT WILL NO LONGER BE A RUN WHAT YOU BRUNG. THERE WILL BE ABSOLUTELY NO FULL SIZE SUVs or PICKUPS ALLOWED. A full size car is acceptable. All vehicles must be run at manufactured height, no lift kits.

There are very few rules for this event, and here they are:

- 1. Other than what is listed, it must be a stock manufactured car.
- 2. No Bumper Covers.
- 3. Absolutely no studded tires, chains or any traction enhancement devices. Absolutely no loading of
  - a. tires, and only one tire per wheel is allowed. No size constraints. All tires must be DOT street tire approved.
- 4. No 4 wheel drives or all wheel drives allowed. On 4 wheel drives, one drive shaft must be removed.
  - a. On all wheel drives, either the front or rear must be unhitched. Cannot be done electronically.
- 5. Regular antifreeze allowed.
- 6. MINIMUM AGE TO COMPETE IS 14 YEARS OLD WITH PARENT CONSENT.
- 7. Only one passenger allowed per vehicle- in the front seat only. (MINIMUM PASSENGER AGE IS 14 YEARS OLD WITH PARENT CONSENT) (UNDER 14 YEARS OLD, IS ALLOWED UNDER SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES WITH PRIOR APPROVAL AND SAFETY CHECK DAY OF- CALL 207-432-7714)

## **MANDATORY SAFETY RULES!**

1. DRIVER AND PASSENGER MUST HAVE WORKING SEAT BELTS. FIVE POINT HARNESSES SUGGESTED BUT NOT MANDATORY.

1A. ALL GLASS EXCEPT WINDSHIELD MUST BE REMOVED.

- 2. ALL DOORS MUST BE WELDED OR CHAINED SHUT.
- 3. ALL HOODS MUST HAVE A 16" HOLE CUT IN THEM.
- 4. ALL VEHICLES MUST HAVE WORKING FIRE EXTINGUISHER

- 5. DRIVER AND PASSENGER WINDOW NET IS MANDATORY (IF HAVING A PASSENGER). MUST BE ABLE TO BE TAKEN DOWN. RECOMMENDED RACE CAR STYLE WINDOW NET, CAN BE MADE OUT OF SEAT BELTS, BUT AT TECH DISCRETION. THIS IS FOR YOUR SAFETY, MAKE IT SAFE.
- 6. EVERYONE MUST WEAR APPROVED HELMET AND GLOVES, LONG SLEEVED SHIRTS AND NO FLIP FLOPS. FIRE SUITS ARE NOT MANDATORY BUT HIGHLY RECOMMENDED.
- 7. A FOUR POINT CAGE IS HIGHLY RECOMMENDED, BUT NOT MANDATORY. CAGE CAN HAVE A HOOP FROM SIDE TO SIDE AND 1 LEG FORWARD ON EACH SIDE. ABSOLUTELY NO BARS IN FRONT OF THE RADIATOR. NO REINFORCEMENT OF ANY FENDERS ALLOWED. FULL CAGES ACCEPTED

7A. BOTH FRONT DOORS MAY HAVE A PIECE OF FLAT STOCK 3/16" THICK BY 6" WIDE WELDED TO THEM, OR 2" X 2" SQUARE TUBING. THEY MAY NOT EXTEND MORE THAN 4" AHEAD OF DOOR OR BEHIND DOOR.

- 8. BATTERIES MAY BE RELOCATED BEHIND DRIVER SEAT AND MUST BE IN AN APPROVED BOX AND COVERED AND TERMINALS COVERED. NO BATTERIES WILL BE ALLOWED IN TRUNK.
- 9. WINDSHIELD WIPERS ARE ALLOWED. SCREENS MAY BE USED INSTEAD OF WINDSHIELD
- 10. ABSOLUTELY NO ALCOHOL ALLOWED IN PIT AREA, OR IN RACE VEHICLES. ALCO SENSORS MAY BE USED IF DEEMED NECESSARY.
- 11. ALL COSTUME ITEMS MUST BE SECURELY ATTACHED EITHER INSIDE OR OUTSIDE OF VEHICLE.
- 12. A RACING STYLE FUEL CELL IS NOT MANDATORY BUT RECOMMENDED. FUEL CELL MUST BE CENTERED IN THE TRUNK. NO CUTTING OF THE TRUNK. NO CUTTING OF THE TRUNK FLOOR OR REAR FIREWALL ALLOWED. IF FUEL CELL IS LOCATED IN THE TRUNK, MUST HAVE A SHEET METAL FIRE WALL SEPARATING TRUNK FROM DRIVER COMPARTMENT.
- 13. FUEL CELL MUST BE MOUNTED WITH A MINIMUM OF TWO 2" BY 1/4 INCH STRAPS.

Additional -You must provide a scorer to be eligible for prize money. It will be allowed to come race for fun without a scorer. Anybody that we feel is out there other than to race, will be blackflagged. The scorer must attend the scorer meeting. Be prepared for all weather, if score cards can't be read, it is not the track's responsibility. We will supply score sheets, but it is your responsibility to supply clipboards and pencils. -All drivers must attend the drivers meeting -Line up will be: pass tech and then directly go to line up. Once you have lined up, you can no longer work on car. -Red flags will be used in an emergency situations. Situations include but not limited to: Roll over, drivers door to traffic, fire. -All race cars & drivers must be signed in and in the pits one hour before post time.

**PURSE** \$1,500, \$400, \$300, \$200, \$100 (Payout is guaranteed, however, could increase with car count and race sponsors)

Entry fee for this event is \$75 for car and driver's pit fee, passenger fee is \$40 (includes pit fee) and pit fee will be \$25. Anybody caught with a non paying passenger will not be allowed to race. Passengers MUST BE signed up at time of registration.

If you do not want to get in line early in the cold, you can pre register. Pre-Registrations will be lined up in the front in the order we receive registration and payment. You still will be required to be there in time to get through and pass tech before tech closes. Pre-registrations have to be received by December 31, 2021.

General admission for the grandstands will be \$12 for adults over 12 yrs old, \$10 for Seniors & Military, and kids under 12 are free. Pit Gate opens at 9:00 am and events start at 1:00 pm on Saturday, January 22, 2022. The Main Gate will open at 11:00 am.
