



## RULES OF THE CAMPING AREA- RIVERSIDE/DIRT SIDE

1. Seasonal Campers with electricity ,power will not be turned on until Friday, May 16, 2026.
- 1a. **NO AC Units are to be left on when not on property. We have a Zero Tolerance for this. All units must be shut off when you leave.**
2. NO CAMPFIRES without a fire ring, truck rim, etc not exceeding a 24" diameter size. NO fires allowed during high risk/red flag times. All fires must be extinguished by midnight. No fires shall be left burning unattended or when you retire for the night.
3. Quiet time is midnight to 8 a.m. Be Respectful to your fellow campers.
4. ALL campsites must be kept neat and clean. Any trash around your camper is expected to be picked up. If your campsite is not clean when you depart, you will not be allowed to camp again for the season. NO LEAVING TRASH BEHIND. You must take your trash with you.
5. ABSOLUTELY NO DISCHARGING OF GRAY OR BLACK WATER ONTO THE GROUNDS. Anyone caught doing this will be evicted immediately and will be reported to the proper authorities.
6. This is a family camping zone. Remember there are kids around, so please watch your language, and actions. Be respectful to other campers.
7. 10 MPH speed limit at all times on the premises. There will be a ZERO tolerance for stunt or reckless driving in the camping area or on the premises. If you are caught, or anyone in your party is caught, (in your party includes someone visiting your camping site) your camping rights will be revoked, and your license to race at Riverside Speedway may be revoked for the balance of the season. NO RIDING DIRT BIKES ON PROPERTY EXCEPT FOR THE MOTO TRACK DURING BUSINESS HOURS. OTHER MOTORIZED VEHICLES ARE SUBJECT TO TRACK DISCRETION (GOLF CARTS, SXS).
8. Polite, quiet, leashed dogs are allowed in the camping area. **YOU MUST REMOVE YOUR DOG'S WASTE.**
9. **NO fireworks, firecrackers, etc. on the premises.**
10. No fighting will be tolerated.
11. Firearms of any type are prohibited.
12. Camping at Riverside Speedway is at your own risk. We will not be responsible for personal injury, damages to personal property, lost or stolen property, or other risks. Campers must be aware that the property is subject to flooding.
13. Local Law Enforcement and Riverside Speedway staff will patrol the premises. There will be no tolerance for underage drinking or smoking (or any other illegal activity). Any alcohol is to be consumed only in the camping area around the campers. Alcoholic beverages are to never be brought off the campground to other areas of the facility. Anyone caught violating this is subject to ejection from the grounds.

14. Campsites will be assigned by Riverside Speedway staff. Campers must be parked as instructed by staff.

15. Trespassing onto other secured parts of the facility besides the campground after hours, and not during an event is strictly prohibited without express permission from an authorized track official. Anyone caught trespassing will be asked to leave and proper authorities notified.

18. If you are asked to leave due to any violation of this agreement, or general track rules and regulations no refunds will be given or will be owed.
